Ephesians 5:21-33 (NIV)

- ²¹ Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.
- ²² Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord.
- ²³ For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior.
- ²⁴ Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything.
- ²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her
- ²⁶ to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word,
- ²⁷ and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.
- ²⁸ In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.
- ²⁹ After all, no one ever hated his own body, but he feeds and cares for it, just as Christ does the church--
- ³⁰ for we are members of his body.
- ³¹ "For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and <u>be united</u> (cleave) to his wife, and the two will become <u>one flesh</u>."
- ³² This is a profound mystery--but I am talking about Christ and the church.
- ³³ However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.
