**Psalm 71:2 (NASB)** In Your righteousness deliver me and rescue me; Incline Your ear to me and save me.

**Psalm 72:4 (NASB)** Save the children of the needy.

**Psalm 85:4 (NASB)** Restore us, O God of our salvation,

**Psalm 85:7 (NASB)** Show us Your lovingkindness, O LORD, And grant us Your salvation.

**Psalm 86:2 (NASB)** Preserve my soul, O You my God, save Your servant who trusts in You.

**Psalm 106:47 (NASB)** Save us, O LORD our God, And gather us from among the nations,

**Psalm 109:26 (NASB)** Help me, O LORD my God; Save me according to Your lovingkindness.

**Psalm 119:94 (NASB)** I am Yours, save me; For I have sought Your precepts.

**Jeremiah 17:14 (NASB)**

<sup>14</sup> Heal me, O LORD, and I will be healed; Save me and I will be saved, For You are my praise.

**Isaiah 7:3-17**

<sup>3</sup> Then the LORD said to Isaiah, "Go out now to meet Ahaz... at the end of the conduit... <sup>4</sup> and say to him, 'Take care and be calm, have no fear and do not be fainthearted.

<sup>10</sup> Then the LORD spoke again to Ahaz, saying, <sup>11</sup> "Ask a sign for yourself from the LORD your God; make *it* deep as Sheol or high as heaven ."

**Isaiah 9:6-7 (NASB)**

<sup>6</sup> For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

**Luke 1:46-47 (NASB)**

<sup>46</sup> And Mary said: "My soul exalts the Lord, And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.
